### 1. Founding documents

1 file (11.12.1980 – 26.03.1981)

The series includes the Society's registration certificate for the Province of British Columbia *Ministry* of *Consumer and Corporate Affairs* and the Society's statutes with the list of founding members.

### 2. Annual General Meeting minutes

3 files (15.01.1982 – 10.01.2010)

The series includes (if they have been preserved) aside from the Annual General Meeting minutes, a list of the members, a list of events taking place over the year, cashbox report, list of members attending the meetings, financial report presented to the Canadian government.

### 3.Information Meeting minutes

1 file(18.09.1981 – 17.02.1989)

The series includes minutes, documents associated with changes to the statutes or other principles. The series includes draft/rough copies of documents. Meetings were held irregularly...

### **4.Directors Meeting minutes**

3 files (20.04.1981 – 6.10.2009)

The series includes minutes, missing original documents have been replaced with copies or draft/rough copies.

### 5. Society for the Advancement of Estonian Studies in Canada economic documents

17 files (1981 - 2001)

The series includes bookkeeping documents, correspondence between banks and Society administrators. 1981 – 1988 in addition to bookkeeping documents, member lists, meeting minutes and correspondences have also been archived. Metsaülikool (Forest University) (MÜLK 97) and EMS VO cashbox documents make up one file. Cashbox income and expense orders, cheque books.

Letters sent by the SAESC directors, if possible with extra documents. In chronological order.

Letters sent to SAESC, notices. In chronological order.

## 8.Materials associated with the creation of the Estonian Chair at Simon Fraser University and Estonian-themed lecture courses

4 files (6.05.1981 – 12.10.1988)

Includes the mediator between the Society and SFU, Dr. Laurence Kitching's, memos to the SAESC directors, Estonian-themed lecture course programs and introductory documents. Document drafts that describe the course of the discussions have also been archived. One of the largest actions by the SAESC was a book donation to the university library from which all copies of the various lists have been preserved, as a final copy cannot be determined. The series includes a selection of newspaper

articles and clippings about associated topics.

## 9.Documents associated with lecture and events organized by the Estonian community in Vancouver

5 files (1981 – 13.02.2010)

Includes a list of lectures organized by SAESC, presentations about the Society's activities, event programs, preparatory documents and announcements. Also includes an overview of activities compiled for the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Society with a lecture program and schedule for the gathering as well as Metsaülikool Läänerannikul (MÜLK) (Forest University) documents. Added to the latter is Olev Träss' speech MÜLK 85.
